- How to join:
 - 1) Teachers give the group code to students, and ask them to join it.
 - 2) Students log into Edmodo using their Username (or email address) and Password.
 - 3) 'Groups (+)' is in the left column. Click the plus (+) symbol.
 - 4) Two options appear: Create, Join. → Click 'Join'.
 - 5) Enter the group code, '6eran7'. \rightarrow Then, they are IN.


