The workshop is sponsored by the Australian Centre for International Agricultural Research (ACIAR).

Objectives

The three-day workshop will focus on the scaling of agricultural innovations with particular reference to public-private partnerships and supporting greater contributions and effectiveness of the private sector to sustainable intensification. It will identify lessons learned from a variety of effective outscaling and upscaling case studies in the South Asian Region (India, Bangladesh and Nepal) and Australia.

Presenters

The workshop will be addressed by leading representatives from the private sector, NGOs and government agencies, all of whom have been involved in successful scaling exercises. The workshop will also feature successful examples of private sector scaling experience from Australia. The workshop thus provides an excellent opportunity for co-learning and networking.

Among the workshop outcomes will be creation of knowledge and collaboration networks among participants; and the development of effective scaling guidelines for the private sector, government and NGOs that will be useful in stimulating agricultural innovations.
